Danger

- **Do not** let water or any other liquid or flammable detergent enter the appliance to avoid electric shock and/or a fire hazard.
- **Do not** clean the appliance with water or any other liquid or a (flammable) detergent to avoid electric shock and/or a fire hazard.

Warning

- Check if the voltage indicated on the bottom of the appliance corresponds to the local mains voltage before you connect the appliance.
- If the mains cord is damaged, you must have it replaced by distributor, or a service center authorized by distributor or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- Do not use the appliance if the plug, the mains cord or the appliance itself is damaged.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

- There should be at least 40cm free space around or above the appliance.
- Do not place anything on top of the appliance and do not sit on the appliance.
- **Do not** place the appliance directly below an air conditioner to prevent condensation from dripping onto the appliance.

- Make sure all filters are properly installed before you switch on the appliance.
- Only use the original filters specially intended for this appliance. Do not use any other filters.
- Avoid knocking against the appliance (the air inlet and outlet in particular) with hard objects.
- Always lift or move the appliance by the handle at the back of the appliance.
- Do not insert your fingers or objects into the air outlet.
- **Do not** use this appliance when you have used indoor smoke-type insect repellents or in places with oily residues, burning incense or chemical fumes.
- **Do not** use the appliance near gas appliances, heating devices or fireplaces.
- Always unplug the appliance after use and before you clean it.
- **Do not** use the appliance in a room with major temperature changes, as this may cause condensation inside the appliance.
- The appliance is only intended for household use under normal operating conditions.
- **Do not** use the appliance in wet surroundings or in surroundings with high ambient temperatures.
- The appliance does not remove carbon monoxide (CO) or radon (Rn). It cannot be used as a safety device in case of accidents with combustion processes and hazardous chemicals.
- To prevent radio interference, the appliance should be kept at least 2 meters away from any device that uses radio waves.




Before First Use

Placing the filters

The appliance comes with all filters fitted inside. Please take off packing of the filter before use. Remove all filters, unpack them and place them back back into the appliance as described below

Note: Make sure you insert the filters in the correct position.

1. Put the appliance upside down on a soft cloth to avoid scratching. To open the base cover, you need to find an arrow point ▲ on the base cover corresponding the LOCK position. Turn the base cover counterclockwise from LOCK to OPEN position, then the lock is released.




2. Remove the base cover and take out the new filter.




3. Remove the Plastic Packaging from the filter.



4. Put the filter back into the appliance.




5. Turn the base cover clockwise from $\mbox{\bf OPEN}$ position to $\mbox{\bf LOCK}$ position. You will hear a "click" sound, the base cover is fastened.



Using The Appliance

About the control panel



1. Put the plug in the wall socket

All lights will turn on at once and you will hear a beep.



2. Press the power button to switch on the appliance.

3. Fan speed adjustment

The fan speed light indicates at which fan speed the appliance is operating. Press Speed button & to adjust fan speed level. There are three levels. 1~3 refers to Low, Medium, High.

Tips: When the appliance is switched on, the fan speed is at the medium level.

4. Sleep mode

When the appliance is in Sleep Mode, it works very quietly. Only the \bigcirc and \bigcirc buttons (If setting the timer) will be at half brightness. All other buttons' light will be off. Press any other buttons (except \bigcirc and \bigcirc buttons) to exit the sleep mode.

5. Light

When the purifier is powered on, the light displays white.

>> Working status

- 1) Turn on the purifier and then the bright-white light will be opened by default and the breathing mode is turned on as well.
- 2) Short press the 🗘 button, change to bright-white; then short press once, change to half-bright white; short press once, change to colorful gradient mode; and short press again, turn off the light.
- 3) Long press -\(\frac{1}{2}\)- button 3 seconds, and the breathing mode is turned on. And long press 3 seconds, turn off it.
- 4) In colorful gradient status, long press \diamondsuit button 3 seconds. The lights stay on (red, orange, yellow, green, cyan, blue, purple), without breathing mode.

Then long press - 2- 3 seconds and the breathing mode is turned on.

>> Standby status

Night color is orange and cold-white. Press $-\Displayline{\mathbb{A}}$ button turn on night light, the light is orange with half-light and you will hear a "beep" sound. Then press $-\Displayline{\mathbb{A}}$ button again, night light enters the cycle in order by fully bright \rightarrow cold white, half bright \rightarrow fully bright \rightarrow turn off \rightarrow orange, half bright...

6. Setting timer

- 1. Press \circlearrowleft to turn on or off the timer, and to cycle through timer options (2 hours, 4 hours, or 8 hours).
- 2. The air purifier will automatically power off once the timer is finished.

NOTE: Pressing \circlearrowleft or unplugging the air purifier will cancel the timer.

7. Keylock mode

- 1) Press (a) button to activate Keylock mode, all buttons are locked at this mode; If your house has young child, we suggest using this mode.
- 2) To cancel the keylock mode, just press and hold (🔠) button for 3 seconds.

8. Filter replacement light

When indicator $\sqrt[4]{3}$ lights, it means that you should check the filter to see if it needs to be cleaned or replaced.

Note: The filter's lifetime is based to your house air quality and using time. Using the appliance in a humid environment will reduce the lifetime of the filter.

9. Memory Function

When the air purifier is plugged in, it will remember its previous fan speed setting.

Filter Replacement

>> When Should I Replace the Air Filter?

It is recommended to change the air filter every 6–8 months. However, you may need to change your filter sooner or later depending on how often you use your air purifier and your house air quality. It is important to watch out for the following signs of expired filter:

- Increased operating noise
- Decreased airflow
- Clogged filter
- Increased presence of odors

NOTE:


- The environment in which the air purifier being used may also extend or shortenthe lifetime of the the air filter. Using your air purifier in an environment of heavy pollution may mean you will need to change the air filter more often.
- If the air pollution in your environment is very high, there is a possibility that the filters may not be completely effective and may need to be replaced before '\sum', lights up.
- Remember to reset the air purifier after changing the air filter.
- Using the appliance in a humid environment will reduce the lifetime of activated carbon filter and HEPA filter.

Tip: Only use Official RENPHO replacement parts to maintain product performance.(Search for: RP-AP088-F1/F2)

>> How to replace the Air Filter?

- 1. Switch off the appliance and unplug it. (a)
- 2. Put the appliance upside down on a soft cloth to avoid scratching. To open the base cover, you need to find an arrow point on the base cover corresponding the LOCK position. Turn the base cover counterclockwise from LOCK to OPEN position, then the base cover is released. (b)





3. Remove the old filter. (c)




4. Remove the packaging material of the new filter. (d)



5. Put the new filter back into the appliance. (e)



6. Turn the base cover clockwise from **OPEN** position to **LOCK** position, and you will hear a "click" sound. The base cover is fastened. (f)




7. Put the plug in the wall socket and switch on the appliance again. (g)



8. Reset Filter's lifetime.

After replacing the filters, when you switch on the appliance, '\(\infty\)' the replace filter light still lights up. You need to reset the filter 's lifetime sensor, so that the appliance can calculate the filters' lifetime.

- 1). Plug in the air purifier and turn it on.
- 2). Press and hold '\(\sigma\)' for 3 seconds.
- 3). Release '\overline{\mathbb{N}}' and the light will turn off, indicating that the reset is completed.



>> Filter Replacement Force Mode

When using the air purifier in an environment of heavy pollution, the lifespan of the air filter may be significantly reduced. You can change the filters even if 'obe not light up. Follow the steps below to perform a hard reset.

- 1). Replace the air filters as mentioned in the Filter Replacement section.
- 2). Plug in the air purifier and keep in standby mode.
- 3). Press and hold '\(\infty\)' for 3 seconds, and it will light up.
- 4). Press and hold '\(\sigma\)' again for 3 seconds, and it will turn off. The reset is now completed.

Clean Air Purifier

In order to keep your purifier working with more efficiency and life-time, clean the filter (pre-filter side only) every 2 weeks following the Instruction Below:

- 1). Clean out any dust, hair, or furs remaining on the pre-filter by using the vacuum hose.
- 2). Clean out any dust, hair, or furs remaining on the bottom cover by using the vacuum hose.
- 3). DO NOT wash the filter with any water or liquid.

Storage

Unplug the power cord, then wipe the machine clean, put the appliance in the packing bag, then put it in a dry place.

Environment

Do not throw away the appliance with the normal household waste at the end of its life, but hand it in at an official collection point for recycling. By doing this, you help to preserve the environment.
